Celebrate Thanksgiving early with a pre-holiday Popsicle Pairs 1 competition. Diane and I will hold our 6th Popsicle Pairs 1 competition at the Prince George's Equestrian Center on **November 17**, **2024**. You do NOT need to be a member of MGAA to enter and compete. All riders are welcome.

There are pairs divisions for Mixed(Open, Over 25, Intermediate), Novice, Leadline, and Green pairs riders. You may enter as a 2-man pair or a 3-man pair or enter as an individual to be placed on a pair. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Mixed Division will be split into a faster group and a more sedate group. If signing up for the Mixed Division, please pick which speed group you would like to compete in.

The Organizer reserves the right to scramble riders or form 2 or 3-man pairs from individual entries.

The Organizer reserves the right to close entries before the closing date if the facility capacity is reached early.

Special Rules:

- This is fun one-day competition so we are allowing either 2-man or 3-man pairs in each Division.
- The competition will be held in the PGEC 150x300 covered arena. The arena is similar to the other PGEC arenas we have used. The arena has a roof but no walls.
- Since this is only a one-day competition, we are allowing mixed pairs of Open, Over25 and Intermediate riders to compete in one of two Mixed Divisions. A faster division and a more sedate division.
- Please submit only one entry form for each rider/pony combination.
- Pairs will play 12 games per session based on time. There will be two sessions for the day. The time limit for one heat will be a maximum of 1 hour.
- To reduce the cost of holding this competition, we will be awarding no prizes or ribbons. Bragging rights only.
- We will need all riders to volunteer as Chief Refs, Equipment Chiefs, Assistant Refs, or Equipment crew for at least one Division/Session. If you have always wanted to try out being a Chief Ref or Equipment Chef, here is your chance. Contact the Organizer to reserve your request.
- If the arena footing is frozen or the weather is treacherous, the competition will be cancelled and rescheduled if possible. All fees will be refunded.
- We will be using the Rules for Short Arenas. This gives the riders more runout room at Line A.

Divisions:

Number of pairs accepted for each division may be modified as entries warrant. FIVE heats per session is the maximum accepted.

All divisions will play two 10 game sessions.

The 2024 IMGA/MGAA Mounted Games Rulebook will be used. Competition Format is Informal Pairs

- Novice: GR15.1.2 Novice: The Novice Division is reserved for riders who are new to the sport of Mounted Games, or are beginner riders. Novice: GR15.1.2 Novice: The Novice Division is reserved for riders who are new to the sport of Mounted Games, or are beginner riders. Riders are competing at a walk and trot and may canter between skills. Riders may be assisted on the field of play if necessary. Riders should be able to safely navigate their pony without a leadline, but a leader/handler may be used when needed for assistance with a specific task or skill. Leg-ups and mounting blocks in accordance with MGAA GR19.4, are also permitted. This division is open to all ages. The Novice division is not for Open, O25, or Intermediate riders. Maximum of 5 Pairs accepted
- Leadline: GR15.1.1.1 Leadline Ponies: Leadline Ponies may be used in other divisions and are exempt from rule GR1.10. This is the only division where a pony ridden in another division may take part. In turn, the races a pony being used in the Leadline Division takes part in will not count towards its race count limit stated in rule GR1.10. Entry fee is \$25 per rider. Maximum of 3 Pairs or 3 Teams accepted if the schedule allows.
- <u>Green:</u> GR15.1.1.1 Green Ponies. This Division is for the training of ponies new to Mounted Games. Iriders in this division must be Intermediate, Open or Over 25 level riders. If the Chief Referee deems the pony unsafe, the pony/rider will be asked to leave the arena. Mounting blocks are permitted in this division in accordance with MGAA GR19.4.
 <u>Maximum of 5 Pairs accepted</u> Green ponies will be accepted if there is room in the schedule.
- <u>Mixed:</u> Pairs may be made up of a mixture of Over25, Open and Intermediate riders. No Green ponies or Novice riders allowed. Mounting blocks are permitted in this division in accordance with MGAA GR19.4. <u>Maximum of 20 Pairs accepted (10 Mixed Fast, 10 Mixed Slow) if the schedule allows.</u>

GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Payment Online Entries</u>: Entries may be completed using the Popsicle Pairs 1 online form. You will receive an email giving the information you used to enter the competition. Please feel free to enter using: https://www.cognitoforms.com/MGAA1/PopsiclePairs1

<u>Payment:</u> Checks and money orders should be written to <u>Maryland Equestrian Foundation</u>. Payments may also be made by VENMO using the account <u>@MDEQFND</u>

Arena: The competition is using the PGEC covered 150 x 300 ft. arena, and the outdoor warm up ring next to the covered arena.

<u>Weather Plans:</u> The competition will be cancelled if the weather has caused the arena footing to freeze or the weather is treacherous in the area. If for some reason the competition is cancelled, all entry fees will be refunded.

<u>Stabling:</u> There is a one-day charge of \$25 for stall use. Additional stall days are \$25 per day per stall. You do not need to strip stalls when leaving. Stabling is limited to <u>Barns S1 and S2 ONLY</u>. No other barns may be used.

Water: Water is available on the grounds. There are fast food places near the PGEC.

<u>Refunds</u>: If weather or a PGEC closure causes the competition to be cancelled or you will be unable to attend due to weather or illness, all entry fees will be refunded. There will be a \$5 fee for rider cancellation if using VENMO.

<u>Change Requests</u>: Any changes or cancellations <u>must</u> be made in writing using the organizer's mailing address: <u>beaks535i@gmail.com</u>. Requests made via Facebook or text messages are **NOT** considered valid requests.

Camping:

From I-81 North: Take I-66 East to Front Royal/Washington. Merge onto I-495 South/Capital Beltway Exit 64A to Richmond. (I-495 & I-95 split. Be sure to stay on I-495, NOT onto I-95 to Richmond). Cross Woodrow Wilson Bridge and take exit 11A/MD Route 4, South/East/Pennsylvania Avenue to Upper Marlboro. Follow 7 miles to Upper Marlboro exit. Turn right at Stop sign. Prince George's Equestrian Center/Show Place Arena to the right.

From I-95 North: Stay on I-95 N until it merges with I-495. Stay on I-95/495. Cross Woodrow Wilson Bridge and take exit 11A/MD Route 4, South/East/Pennsylvania Avenue to Upper Marlboro. Follow 7 miles to Upper Marlboro exit. Turn right at Stop sign. Prince George's Equestrian Center/Show Place Arena to the right.

From Frederick I-70: Take to I-270 South. I 270 south becomes Capital Beltway I-495 East. Take I 495 East to exit 11A/MD Route 4, South/East/Pennsylvania Avenue to Upper Marlboro. Follow 7 miles to Upper Marlboro exit. Turn right at Stop sign. Prince George's Equestrian Center/Show Place Arena to the right.

From Baltimore I-695 E Baltimore Beltway: Take outer loop to Glen Burnie. Merge onto I-97/Exit 4 (in the left 2 lanes) to Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Take Route 32 W/MD Route 3 South, Exit 7 toward Bowie/Odenton. Route 3 becomes Route 301 South. Exit at Route 4 East/Pennsylvania Avenue toward Washington. Take first exit to Stop sign. Turn left into Equestrian Center.
